



## **The New Haven Pride Center David Knapp Scholarship**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **2012/13 INFORMATION SHEET**

##### **PURPOSE:**

The New Haven Pride Center David Knapp Scholarship Fund was established to provide scholarship awards to gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender or questioning persons, and allies who are either: a) residents of Connecticut attending accredited technical, vocational, undergraduate or graduate programs; or, b) non-Connecticut residents who are attending accredited technical, vocational, undergraduate or graduate programs in Connecticut. The New Haven Pride Center Scholarship Committee will determine award recipients. During the application review period, the Committee will consider academic accomplishments, leadership, community service, financial need and personal story. The scholarship was named for David Knapp in early 2011, in honor of his service to the LGBT community and his support of the New Haven Pride Center.

##### **APPLICATION PROCESS AND DEADLINE:**

Applications must be received by the Committee, at the address listed below, no later than Friday, June 1, 2012. The Committee will review applications and awardees will be selected in mid-June 2012. Notification will be sent to all applicants about the status of their applications by the second week of July 2012.

##### **AWARDS:**

The New Haven Pride Center will award two scholarships for the 2012/2013 school year; each award will be in the amount of \$500. One \$500 award will be given to a high-school senior, college freshman or college sophomore; a second \$500 award will be given to a student continuing or pursuing education at a level higher than college sophomore. Each award check will be given to enrolled recipients via their institution's Financial Aid Office, at the beginning of the term.

##### **ELIGIBILITY:**

The eligibility rules governing the competition for the New Haven Pride Center David Knapp Scholarship include the following:

1. Eligible applicants include all gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender and questioning students and allies.
2. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, or hold a valid student visa during the period in which the award is dispersed (school year 2012/13).

3. During the academic year in which the award is dispersed, recipient must be a) a resident of Connecticut enrolled in an accredited vocational, undergraduate or graduate program leading to a degree, certificate, license, or diploma in their field; or b) enrolled in an accredited vocational, undergraduate or graduate program in Connecticut leading to a degree, certificate, license, or diploma in their field.
4. A recipient from an accredited vocational, undergraduate or graduate program must have earned a minimum cumulative average of a C+ in all prior college level coursework.
5. Recipients must meet all satisfactory academic progress requirements normally applied by the institution for its federal, state, and institutional financial aid programs.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Official high school and/or college transcripts must be sent by the institution directly to the New Haven Pride Center (address below). All materials must be received (not postmarked) by the Center by Friday, June 1, 2012.
2. Applicants must meet all material submission requirements and deadlines that are included in the annual announcement of the competition. An applicant must provide the following documents in order to be considered for the award:
  - a. Completed and signed Application Form with general demographic information.
  - b. Written statement describing how the student meets the requirements of the scholarship program as described in the eligibility section above.
  - c. Any other documents subsequently requested by the Scholarship Committee.
3. Applicants may include additional information to support their application, including documentation of activities cited in their statements.
4. **Applications must be RECEIVED (not mailed) by Friday, June 1, 2012.** No application received after this date will be considered. Applications can be submitted in two ways:
